



ACADIANA HOUSING ALLIANCE 2023 HOUSING PRIORITIES

- 1. Remove outdated legislation that prevents opportunities for the creation of group homes and other shared living scenarios.
- 2. Increase equitable development with the intent to undo the negative impacts of redlining.
- 3. Increase affordable developments in proximity to jobs, services, and public transportation.
- 4. Develop a strategy to help homeowners who do not have the funds for necessary home repairs.
- 5. Create a convergent partnership with healthcare providers to increase access to affordable housing for those suffering from health problems.
- 6. Recruit more local developers to partner with and commit to affordable housing development.
- 7. Increase Homebuyer Education & Financial Literacy opportunities.
- 8. Invest in sustainable development for quality neighborhoods (affordable opportunities, long-term floodwater management planning, etc.), as well as weatherization upgrades for older housing stock.
- 9. Increase home-ownership opportunities for low- and moderate-income renters, i.e. a Section 8 home-ownership program, mobile home-ownership as an affordable option, and "Soft Second Programs" (a second mortgage with payments that are forgiven, deferred, or subsidized in some fashion, generally until resale of the mortgaged property)
- 10. Improve alignment between all financial counseling services and create a strong marketing campaign for financial literacy that caters to a broader group of individuals.
- 11. Increase permanent and emergency housing opportunities for the displaced households in the region.
- 12. Improve or establish public transportation mechanisms for individuals living in affordable housing to travel to and from their jobs.
